

## Course of Studies Samples – Form III (Grade 9) and Form IV (Grade 10)

Revised: March 27, 2006

Below is a table to help Form III (grade 9) and Form IV (grade 10) students plan their course of studies. This table illustrates what courses or credits most students should complete by the end of the Fourth Form year. Following the table are eight sample course selections. The samples are not recommendations but serve as illustrations. As you plan your course of studies, try to think in terms of two year blocks.

Discipline	# of Courses	Course Titles
ARTS	1	Any three credit course or its equivalent in either Art, Music or Theatre
Computer	2	Any of the introductory computer courses (can be taken in Form V or VI as well)
English	2	Foundations of Literature & Writing I Foundations of Literature & Writing II
Health	2	Health I & Health II (includes CPR)
History	1-2	Historical Perspectives (Forms III or IV) Patterns of European History (Forms IV or V)
Language	2	Completion of at least the second year of study of one foreign language.
Mathematics	2	Any two courses taken in the proper sequence beginning with the first course not yet taken.
Science	1-2	Concept of Physics and Concepts of Chemistry
Athletics	4	Participation in at least two seasons of team sports each year.
