Re: **The John Baglier Class of 1997 Scholarship Award Proposal**

The Academic Programs Committee by a vote of 9-0-0 has endorsed the adoption of the John Baglier Class of 1997 Scholarship Award. The committee asks the faculty to review this proposal and to take action on the proposal at the next faculty meeting. Please be prepared to discuss and vote on the proposal. Thank you.

Citation

An award, established by the family and friends of John Baglier, class of 1997, is given annually to honor a member of the graduating class who has been inspirational by example to his or her peers by excelling in at least one aspect of school life and by the genuine and unwavering support he or she has given fellow students as they strive to achieve their utmost. The award commemorates John's life, his constant visible encouragement of his peers, and his efforts to make the Senior School a better community.

Notes

It is the intent of the award's sponsor that the recipient has excelled in some aspect of school life, including but not limited to academics, visual arts, performing arts, athletics, writing, extracurricular activities, community service, or governance. In addition, the recipient is to have demonstrated continual support to his or her peers and have been inspirational by example. The recipient of the award will receive both a book inscribed with a citation referring to the award and a one thousand dollar scholarship to be used for the first year of college tuition or other related academic expenses. Payment of the scholarship is made upon receipt of an appropriate invoice by the Academy. Should the recipient defer his or her admission, the payment of the award may be postponed by one year.

Selection Process

In March, nomination forms will be available to all students. The completed form is then given to the nominator's advisor. The nominations are reviewed by the Head and Assistant Head Form Advisors who will bring a slate of candidates to the faculty for approval. The approved slate of candidates is voted on by the graduating class. The recipient of the award is announced at the annual Senior Dinner.

Funding

This is an endowed award. Until the endowment is sufficient to underwrite the scholarship and the presentation book, the donor will provide the necessary funds.
